MISSION SUPPORT FOR AUGUST – BEACHY HEAD CHAPLAINCY

This month we continue to support an amazing local charity Beachy Head Chaplaincy Team. In 2004 Ross Hardy saw a desperate need and his vision has grown into a team of trained search and rescue chaplains who patrol on foot and by car, responding to emergency calls and locating the desperate people who are at risk. All chaplains are Christians from local churches whose faith has led them to compassionate action. They reach out with the love of God, without preaching, offering time, space and skilled crisis intervention in order to save lives. Conversations are started, listening, encouraging, offering more hopeful solutions than suicide. They collaborate with local services who value their work highly as they guide individuals towards the help they need. The chaplains are motivated by a belief that no one should face the edge alone and that every life has value. "We don't always know what leads someone to that edge but we believe that one moment of connection can change everything." An example on the website is Michael who says, "I thought I was a failure with no way forward. One conversation gave me the courage to ask for help. I'm starting to see the good in myself again". The chaplaincy team is growing, adapting and building for the future: training new chaplains, strengthening partnerships and working to make their support sustainable for the long term. Please pray this month for this vital work which is needed more than ever in our troubled world.
